Luke 1:39-55

We've provided these questions to give families or groups (of all ages) and individuals an opportunity to reflect on today's message. We hope you'll use them over lunch or dinner today to consider more fully the teaching of Luke 1:39-55.

1. What stands out to you about how Elizabeth - and unborn John the Baptist - respond to Mary and the baby Jesus in her womb?
2. How does Mary understand the relationship between worship and joy (see v. 46)? What does it look like when we attempt to *magnify* something without *rejoicing in it*?
3. What do you rejoice in and therefore, perhaps without realizing, magnify?
4. Consider the reasons Mary praises God in her song. Which of these moves you to praise and worship?
5. How might reflecting deeply on the first coming of Jesus this Advent create in you a longing for the second coming of Christ?
